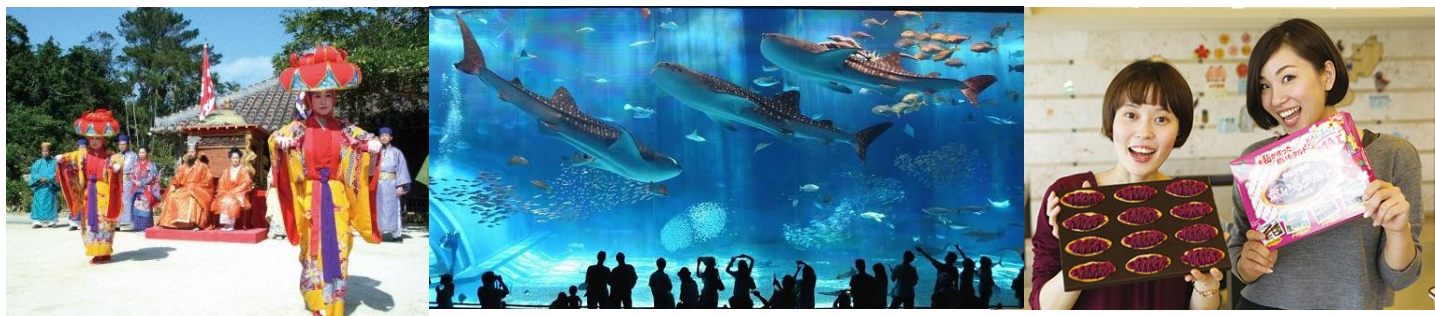

DAY 02 NAHA - ONNA

(MOB/L/D)

- **Umikaji Terrace on Senagajima**, the unique shopping area opened in the summer of 2015. It has over 30 shops, restaurants, cafes, and boutiques. Designed with the concept of a small town by the sea resembling look like Greece, the pristine white buildings are juxtaposed against the blue skies and emerald green sea.
- **American Village** – The perfect place for casual shopping as well as mega department stores, cafes, restaurants that top off the total atmosphere of this little slice of American culture on Okinawa Island.
- **Cape Manzamo** – A sweep of natural grass, covering the top of a high precipice, is beautifully contrasted with the blue sea. Manzamo makes its scenery the most magnificent in Okinawa.

DAY 03 ONNA

- **Churaumi Aquarium** is widely considered Japan's best aquarium. The highlight of a visit to the Churaumi Aquarium is the massive Kuroshio Tank, one of the largest in the world. The tank contains a wide variety of species, the most striking of which are the giant whale sharks and manta rays. Continue to outdoor pools near the waterfront area to watch **Dolphin Show**.

DAY 04 NAHA CITY TOUR

- **Ryukyu Mura Village** is the best sightseeing spot where you can experience Okinawa's culture, performances as well as traditional foods. A wide range of performances are held at the village, including eisa taiko drumming, dances, concerts, parades and re-enacted historical ceremonies.
- **San-A NAHA Main Place** is one of the biggest shopping centres in Okinawa Prefecture where the local people often visit. It offers rich choice of facilities such as supermarkets, restaurants and an electronic products store inside the building.
- **Kokusai Street** – Main street of Naha, shops on both sides of the street are filled with souvenirs, fashions boutiques, gourmet restaurants.

DAY 05 NAHA CITY TOUR

- **Tomari Iyumachi Fish Market** is one of the most famous and popular fish markets on Okinawa. It's located just beside the Tomari fishing port and the market serves the freshest ocean produce caught and landed on the same day. The market is open to all and does a lively business serving private consumers, restaurateurs and retailers.
- **Naminoue Shrine** – Sitting on top a high cliff, overlooking Naminoue Beach and the ocean, it has been the sacred area to offer prayers to Nirai Kanai (world of gods) since the day of old.
- **Shikinaen Garden** - It features beautiful, relatively simple, wooden palace buildings with Okinawan style, red tile roofs and a spacious Japanese style landscape garden with a central pond. In 2000, Shikinaen was among the sites added to the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites under the title Gusuku Sites and Related Properties of the Kingdom of Ryukyu.
- **Ashibinaa Outlet Mall** – over 70 luxury brands are available at discount prices to satisfy your geared-up shopping spirit. You can arrangement your own lunch at the outlet's mall.
